JOURNEY



PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is 'Relationships'. It is about making and maintaining friendships.

English Reading

In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be reading the following texts:

- Escape to Pompeii
- The Diary of a Killer Cat
- Bold Women in History

They will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference, prediction, summarising and vocabulary skills.

English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'Journey' by Aaron Becker. The main writing outcome of this unit is an adventure story. During this unit children will also focusing on the following grammar and punctuation:

- · Present perfect verbs.
- Prepositions
- Conjunctions
- Adverbs
- · Using a and an

Maths

In maths this half term, children will continue their unit on Time. Children will use the terms 'a.m.' and 'p.m.'. They will learn to tell the time to the nearest minute on an analogue clock. They will also look at time calculating durations.

They will also complete a unit of fractions, They will begin by counting in tenths and understanding fractions as a division. We will explore equivalent fractions and simplifying fractions before comparing fractions, before adding and subtracting frac-

Geography

Science



In science children will complete a unit of work on Plant Reproduction. They will look at the structure of plants and understand the significant of different parts in plant development. They will investigate factors that affect plant growth and how plants compete with their peers to disperse seeds.

<u>History</u>

In history this half term, children will be learning about Ancient Greece. They will be answering the over arching question 'What can historians learn about Ancient Greece from sources?'. Within the unit, they will learn about Athenian empire and democracy. They will learn about Greek architecture, arts, theatre and poetry.

In geography this half term, children will be learning about Volcanoes. They will be answering the over arching question "How do volcanoes affect a place?' Within the unit they will learn about the make-up of the earth and how volcanoes are formed, different types of volcanoes and why people choose to live near them.

In RE, the children will be learning Judaism and why celebrating Passover is important.

Computing

In computing, children will be completing the unit 'iConnect'. They will explore the world wide web.

Design and Technology

In Design and technology, children will be completing an unit on mechanical systems. Within this unit they will explore pneumatic systems and then apply this understanding to design and make a pneumatic toy which includes thumbnail

sketches and exploded diagrams.

Music

In music, children will be learning to play the Ukulele as a class.

French
