Curriculum Map – Summer 1

PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is 'Relationships'. We will learn about jealousy, love and loss.

English Reading

In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be reading the following texts:

- How to Train Your Dragon
- The Great Kapok Tree
- Beowulf

They will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference, prediction, summarising and vocabulary skills.

English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'Alba: The Hundred Year Old Fish' by Lara Hawthorne. The main writing outcome of this unit will be a non-fiction piece, where the children will write an information board.



- Recognise the difference between plural and possessive 's'.
- Organise paragraphs
- Rich and varied vocabulary

Maths

In maths this half term, children will also learn about decimals, including dividing by 10 and 100. This will then link to our unit on money, where children will compare and write amounts of money, as well as practise their knowledge of rounding. Children will also learn more about length, mass and volume. This will involve them converting and using rulers to measure.



Science

In science, children will be completing a unit in biology, focusing on living things and their habitats. They will be identifying different ways living things can be grouped. Children will make classification keys to explore which grouping methods are most effective.



History

In history this half term, children will start their first Islamic Civilisations topic. They will learn about Arabia and early Islam, thinking about how the civilisation grows from different tribes, into larger organised groups. This will lead onto their learning in Summer 2 and into Year 5.

Geography

In geography this half term, children will learn about earthquakes. They will learn about what causes earthquakes and which areas are more heavily impacted by them. Children will also learn about the San Andreas fault, as well as how humans live with earthquakes.

RE

In RE children will learn about Christianity and how the message of Jesus spreading.

Design & Technology

In Design & Technology, children will be applying their scientific understanding of electrical circuits to design and create a torch. They will design and evaluate their product against set design criteria.

Music

In music, children will be learning about the samba sound of carnivals

Computing

In computing, children will be completing an 'iProgram' unit to build their programming skills..

French

In French, children will be learning to say different French foods.
