### **PSHE**

The theme for this half term in PSHE is 'Relationships'. We will learn about jealousy, love and loss.

# English Reading

In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be reading the following texts:

- How to Train Your Dragon
- The Great Kapok Tree
- Beowulf

They will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference, prediction, summarising and vocabulary skills.

# English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'Alba: The Hundred Year Old Fish' by Lara Hawthorne. The main writing outcome of this unit will be a non-fiction piece, where the

children will write an information board.

- Recognise the difference between plural and possessive 's.'.
- Organise paragraphs
- Rich and varied vocabulary

#### Maths

In maths this half term, children will learn about time. They will refresh their learning about using 24-hour time. They will also start converting time in minutes to seconds and hours to minutes, as well as being able to solve problems around duration.

Children will also learn about decimals, including dividing by 10 and 100. This will then link to our unit on money, where children will compare and write amounts of money, as well as practise their knowledge of rounding.

## Science

In science, children will be completing a unit in biology, focusing on living things and their habitats. They will be identifying different ways living things can be grouped. Children will make classification keys to explore which grouping methods are most effective.

# **History**

In history this half term, children will finish their unit on the Roman Empire before starting their final Roman unit of Roman Britain. Children will use their prior knowledge and new learning to answer the big question 'What changed in Roman Britain?'

## Geography

In geography this half term, children will learn about coastal processes and landforms. They will learn about the processes that take place around the coast and how this affects the land. Children will learn about the Jurassic coast, coastal habitats and the coast of west Wales.

## <u>RE</u>

In RE children will learn about Christianity and the death and resurrection of Jesus.

# Computing

In computing, children will be completing an 'iProgram' unit to build their programming skills...

# Design & Technology

In Design & Technology, children will be applying their scientific understanding of electrical circuits to design and create a torch. They will design and evaluate their product against set design criteria.
