## PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is Relationships.. Children will learn about different types of families, friendships and trust.

## English Reading

During Spring 2 of year 2 children will continue whole class reading. In our reading over the next half term, we will be working on the key reading skills of year 2. We will have a focus on retrieval and inference. The children will be finding evidence in the text to back up their ideas.

## English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is "The Last Wolf". The main outcome from this text is to write a letter in role as a character persuading to save the trees. They will be focusing on the following



skills:

- Use subordination (if, that)
- Add -er and -est to adjectives
- Use homophones and near homophones
- Use punctuation correctly - apostrophes for contracted forms

## Maths

In maths this half term, children will look at the following topics:

- shapes  
fractions

We will continue to revisit previous topics through starters and fluent in 5.



## Science



In science children will complete a unit of work on Plants. Using their prior knowledge of important plant structures they will look at what factors are needed for successful growth and compare how these needs vary across different plants. We will be growing plants from both seeds and bulbs and compare their survival needs.

## History

In history this half term, children will be learning about The Stone Age. They will learn about Doggerland and how Britain was connected to Europe and also learn about hunters, gatherers and Stone Age tools. Finally, we will look at Stonehenge and what life was like for Skara Brae.

## Geography

In geography this half term, children will study "Weather in Our World". They will learn about the different climates of the world and how the equator is related to climate. They will learn the key features of a tropical climate, polar climate and temperate climate. Children will then be comparing these climates to the climate of the UK.

## Music

In music, children will complete the topic "On This Island".

## Design and Technology

In Design and Technology children will be designing and creating their own moving monster using a linkage mechanism. They will learn key terms such as pivot, lever and linkage.



## RE

In RE children will be learning about Islam and why Muslims visit a Mosque.

## Computing

In computing, children will be completing the unit 'iPub'.
