The children have really enjoyed this week's nursery rhyme. They've all joined in with the actions.

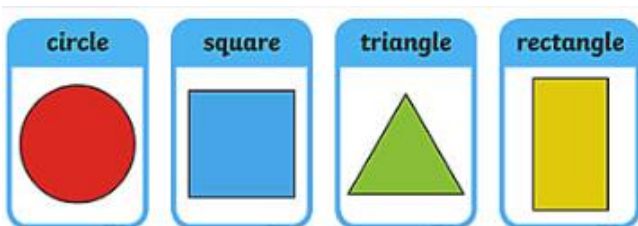
