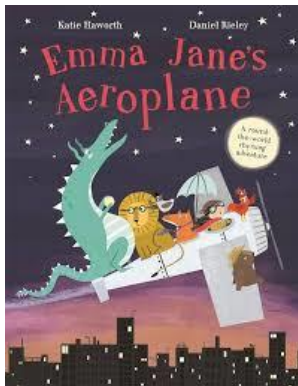
What a great week in Team Daffodils!

Can you retell our innovated story of Emma Jane's Aeroplane?

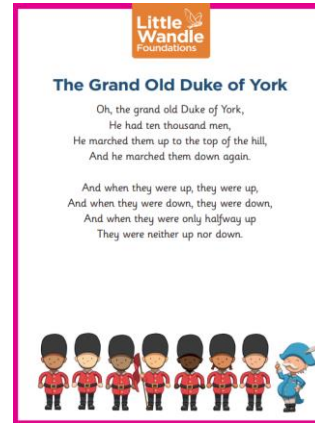
Nursery Rhyme of the Week
