PSHE - Changing Me

Children will look at lifecycles of animals and humans as well as explaining how our bodies have changed since a baby.

English Reading

The Phonics Screening Check will take place around the 10th June. In the meantime, children will continue recapping all graphemes that will most likely come up in the test. After the screening check, children will continue to grow the phonics code and build their confidence to read a range of texts fluently.

English Writing

This term our new focus will be 'Goldilocks and Just One Bear' by Leigh Hodgkinson. We will be aiming to write a traditional story with a new character. Children will use what they have previously learnt as well as using simple description and using a capital letter for places and days of the week.

Maths

In the new term children will continue consolidating previous learning. They will be moving onto time, money, volume and capacity, mass and space.

Children will also continue recalling their number facts to 20 during their fluent in 5 lessons ready for Year 2.



Science

Working Scientifically/Making Connections

In readiness for next academic year, children will consolidate all previous learning taught this year. Children will begin to make connections between taught units of work and they will begin to work scientifically.



History

Ships and Sea Farers

Children will learn about the earliest experiments in floating. They will study how the development of boats emerged. They will explore about trade and exploration at sea and focus on life on ships and the legacy of sea faring.

Geography

Working Hard

Children will learn about the different jobs and roles that adults may do. Children will compare jobs that they may find in the city, countryside and the coast.
