PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is 'Changing Me'. It is about moving classes and also body changes.

English Reading


In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be reading the following texts:

- Bold Women in History (continued)
- The Tin Forest
- The Boy at the Back of the Class

They will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference, prediction, summarising and vocabulary skills.

English Writing

We will continue the text 'Journey' for the first few weeks. The new text we will be focussing on is 'The merchant of Venice' by William Shakespeare. The main writing outcome of this unit is a non-fiction guide. During this unit children will also focus on the following grammar and punctuation:



- Organisational features of non-fiction.
- Grouping related information into paragraphs.

Maths

In maths this half term, children will complete a unit of work on fractions. They will look at equivalent fractions as well as adding and subtracting fractions. They will a unit on Angles. They will learn to identify angles in shapes and know whether they are acute, obtuse or right angles. They will also compare angles. They will also complete a unit on Line and Shape.

They will learn about different types of lines including: horizontal, vertical, parallel, perpendicular. They will also draw 2D and describe 3D shapes. They will also complete a unit on Perimeter. They will learn what perimeter is and how to find the perimeter of shapes.



Science

In science children will complete a unit of work on Working Scientifically. They will complete different enquiry types:

- *Comparative and fair tests
- *Testing over time
- *Research
- *Pattern Seeking
- Grouping, sorting and classifying



History

In history this this half term, children will be learning about Alexander the Great. They will be answering the over arching question "How did Alexander the Great conquer so much land?" Within the unit they will learn about his childhood, education, early battles, conquest of Persia and his death.

Geography

In geography this half term, children will be learning about Climates and Biomes. They will be answering the over arching question "How does climate affect the way people live?" Within the unit they will learn about different climate zones. They will compare the Mediterranean climate with the Temperate climate of the Rhine.

RE

In RE, the children will be learning Judaism and the importance of the Kingdom of Israel. .

Art and Design

In Art and Design, children will complete a unit on abstract art. They will explore how shapes and negative space can be represented in 3D form. They will create an abstract 3D sculpture inspired by the work of Anthony Caro.



Music

In music, children will be learning to play the Ukulele as a class.

French

In French, children will be learning about animals.

Computing

In computing, children will be completing the unit 'iPodcast'. They will create and edit podcasts.
