## PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is 'Changing Me'. We will learn about being unique and preparing for change.

### English Reading

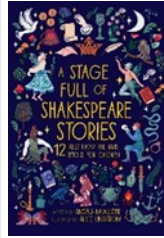
In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be reading the following texts:

- King Arthur and the Knights of the Round Table.
- The Great Kapok Tree.
- Charlotte's Web.

They will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference,

### English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'A Stage Full of Shakespeare Stories – Julius Caesar' by Angela McAllister. The main writing outcome of this unit will be a playscript for a part of the story.



- Organise paragraphs around a theme.
- Build a varied and rich vocabulary.
- Use present and past tenses.

### Maths

In maths this half term, we will learn about area and perimeter. This will be calculating missing lengths and finding the area of rectangles and squares. In geometry, we will be identifying and comparing angles, classifying triangles and quadrilaterals.

Children will learn Roman numerals from 1 to 20 and to 100. In our position and movement topic, describing positions, plotting points and describing translations.



### Science

In science, children will be working scientifically to make links between the different fields of chemistry, biology and physics. They will then make connections to solidify their learning.



### History

In history this half term, children will finish their unit on the Roman Empire before starting their final Roman unit of Roman Britain. Children will use their prior knowledge and new learning to answer the big question 'What changed in Roman Britain?'

### Geography

In geography this half term, children will learn about tourism. They will be answering the big question of how do tourists interact with a place? They will learn about the seaside, types of tourism, mountain adventures and summer in the sun.

### RE

In RE children will learn about Christianity and the messages of Jesus spreading.

### Art & Design

In Art & Design, developing colour mixing skills, using shades and tints to show form and create three dimensions when painting. Children will learn about composition and plan their own still life to paint, applying chosen techniques.



### Music

In music, children will be learning about Rock and Roll.

### French

In French, children will be learning to say different food.

### Computing

In computing, children will be completing an 'iProgram' unit to build their programming skills..
