PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is Changing Me. Looking at increasing independence, differences in females and males and life cycles.

English Reading

During Summer 2 of Year 2 children will continue with whole class reading. Looking at texts such as Flotsam, The Seeds of Friendship and The Three Wolves and the Big Bad Pig. We will continue working on the key reading skills such as inference, retrieval, sequencing and prediction.

English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is "The Tempest". The main outcome from this text is to retell an abridged and adapted version of the story. They will be focusing on the following skills:

- -Use subordination (when, if, that, or because) and co
- empest ordination (or, and, or but).
 - Compared to the second specify.
 - -Add suffixes to spell longer words e.g -ment, -ful.
 - -Use present and past tenses correctly and consistently including the progressive form.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths this half term, children will look at the following topics:

- -Fractions
- -Time
- -Volume

We will continue to revisit previous topics through starters and fluent in 5.

Science

In science children will be working scientifically and making connections.

They will revise all of the topics we have covered so far and look at how to make connections between these topics.

<u>History</u>

In history this half term, children will be learning about the Neolithic Revolution. They will learn about farming during this time and how this has changed. They will also begin to learn about the Bronze Age and what life was life during this time.

<u>Geography</u>

In geography this half term, children will study "Looking After Our World". We will learn the importance of looking after places including our school and local area. We will choose one specific issue and decide on actions to change the world.

Music

In music, children will complete the topic "Myths and Legends".

Computing

In computing, children will be completing the unit 'iBlog'.

Art

In Art we will be working with clay and creating a 3D sculpture. We will explore the way clay can be shaped and joined, learning a range of essential skills for working with this medium.
