# Curriculum Map – Summer 2

## PSHE

The theme in PSHE is 'Changing Me'. Children will think about their social, emotional and physical development as they grow up and move schools.

## English Reading

In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be focusing on a variety of different texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry.

They will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference, prediction, summarising and vocabulary skills.

## English Writing

During this half term children will continue to focus on a range of different stimuli, including books and short clips, to engage them in writing different text types. They will look to independently include a range of writing techniques including:

- Selecting effective vocabulary
- Using a range of adverbial sentence starters

## Maths

In maths this half term, children will be focusing on problem solving and recapping key areas of learning such as ratio, algebra and geometry.

## Science

In science children will complete the unit 'Making Connections' where children will discuss, create and complete an investigation based on which sunglasses are safer than others.

## RE

In RE this half term, children will be learning about fables and they will answer the question 'What can we learn from Aesop's Fables about living a moral life?'. Within the unit they will explore fables and their morals, considering how all decisions have consequences.

## Geography

In geography this half term, children will be answering the overarching question 'What was the greatest change in Birmingham between 1750 and 2020?'. Within this children will be learning about the location of Birmingham and how it has developed and changed across time including population and housing.

## Design and Technology

Children will link Design and Technology and Computing this half term looking at the unit 'Digital World – Navigating the World' In this unit the children will design and programme a navigation tool to produce a multifunctional device for walkers. They will create a 3D CAD using modelling software and will 'pitch' their product to sell it at the end.

## Music

Children will be learning songs linked to their Leaver's Performance.
