PSHE

Our topic is 'Relationships.' We will also be looking at 'Changing me', focusing on self-esteem and puberty.

English Reading

In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be reading the following texts:

- The Anglo-Saxon Boy
- The Explorer

Pupils will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference, prediction, summarising and vocabulary skills.

English Writing

Our new English texts will be 'Bold and Brave Women from Shakespeare' and 'A Stage full of Shakespeare Stories.'

Over the course of the half term, we will be working towards writing a recount and performing a soliloquy! Our feature keys will include:

- Using a variety of tenses within writing
- Using adverbs to indicate degrees of possibility.

Maths

This half term we will be moving from position and direction into measurements, area, perimeter, volume and Roman Numerals.

In these units we will be looking at how to find the perimeter and area of various regular and irregular shapes. In our 'volume' topic, we will be revisiting finding the volume of liquids and beginning to find the volumes of 3D shapes.



Science

In science this half term, we will be moving onto a Biology topic of 'Animals including Humans: Human Timeline.' In this module, we will look at human development, changes through puberty, and how gestation periods differ in different animals.



History

In history, we will be looking at Norse Culture, which will link on from our last two topics looking at the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings. Our focus this half term will be on looking at the connections and similarities that the Norse peoples has with other peoples.

Geography

In Geography this half term, we will be learning all about North and South America, with a disciplinary focus on diversity. Our Geography skill will be looking at four figure references and thematic maps, and we will be discussing the various pros and cons of living in a mega city.

RE

In RE we will be looking at what Buddhist stories teach Buddhists about enlightenment.

Art

In Art we will be learning about the features of installation art and how it can communicate a message. Our focus artist will be Cai Guo-Qiang, and we will be exploring how life experiences can impact art. We will also be looking at how scale and location affect the way that people experience installation art.

Music

In music, we will be exploring Musical Theatre!

French

Our French topic will be on 'Meet my French Family.'

Computing

In Computing we will be exploring web design and construction.
