We have enjoyed learning all about Chinese New Year.

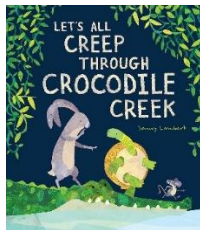
We have also been busy learning about past and present looking how Streethay has changed.
