This week we have been reading our new book Let's all creep through the crocodile creek. We have spoken about different journeys we have been on and different transport we have used.

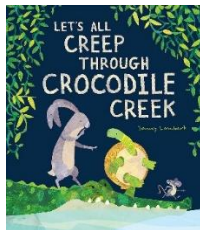
We have also been exploring the outdoor area using our senses on what we can hear, smell and see.

This week we have drawn our preferred way of transport or a place where we like to visit.

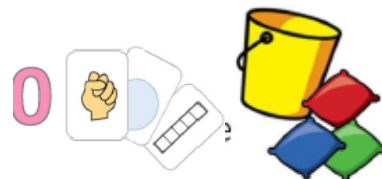
Can you draw your favourite place at home and write why?
