Literacy

Maths

We will be following the Maths, No Problem.

This week we are focusing on counting to 20.

Place a handful of counters or objects on the table, any amount from 11–20. Can children estimate how many counters there are? Check their estimate by counting out a set of ten and then the remaining counters.

Vocabulary:

Eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty, count on, count back, more, less, fewer, how many, order

Phonics

The sounds we are learning phase 4 Tricky Words and recapping Phase 3 Sounds.

Can you write a sentence using your phonics knowledge and a tricky word you have learnt this week?
