This week we have been exploring two key words, full and empty. We have been using these words in play. E.g making potions in the water area and discussing if the containers are full or empty.

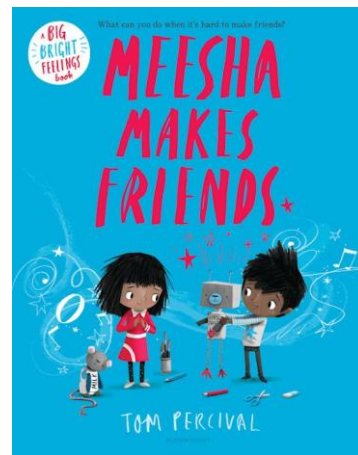
Can you use these key words in your play at home?
