



Daffodils have enjoyed another lovely week at school, exploring the areas all about homes.

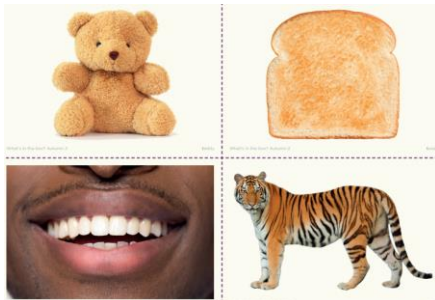
