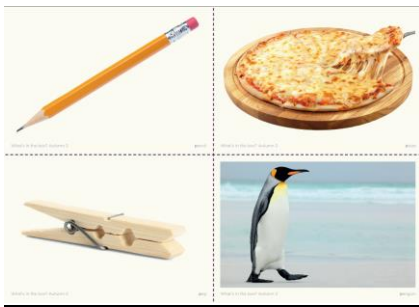

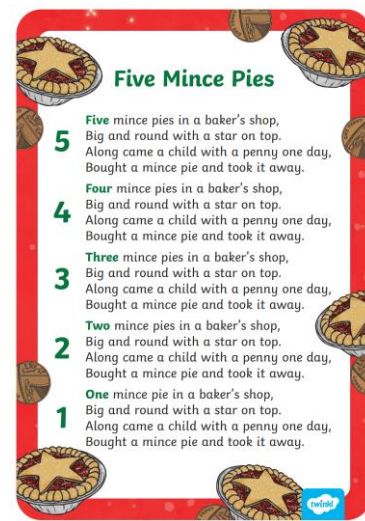

Can you sing our nursery rhyme of the week with the learnt actions?

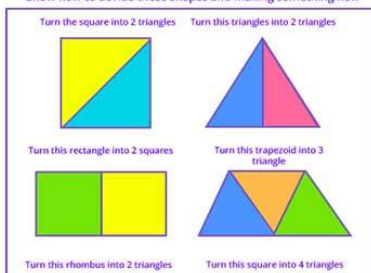


2D Shapes
