

Year 3&4

- Reading – Reading fluency and knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes; developing inference skills, summarising the text, identifying how language, structure, and presentation contribute to meaning.
- Writing – Organising paragraphs around a theme; in narratives, creating setting characters and plots; in non-narrative use simple organisational devices; begin to edit work effectively.
- Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling – conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to express time and cause; fronted adverbials, present perfect form. Using the correct punctuation for direct speech, procession and fronted adverbials.
- Spoken Language - develop competence in spoken language and listening to enhance the effectiveness with which they are able to communicate across a range of contexts and to a range of audiences.
- Handwriting – use the diagonal and horizontal strokes that are needed to join letters.
