Transition

Normally, we would invite families into the school for a transition meeting and tour. Your child would also have had the opportunity to spend time with their new teacher during "Transition Week" at the beginning of July. However, due to the limited number of children we can have in school at the moment and in order to follow the government's guidelines on social distancing, we've had to adjust our arrangements for supporting this year's transition.

This year, transition arrangements will involve

Week commencing 29.6.20

- An email from your child's new teacher, including a teacher "All About Me" Fact File and year group specific letter
- A "Who's Who at St Saviour's" presentation found on the school website under the Our Academy Tab – Our Staff

- An Early Years Information powerpoint presentation
- A new starter information pack

Week commencing 6.7.20

- A Transition Project to be completed at home; a week of planned activities focusing on supporting your child with transitioning to their new class. This project can be found on the school website under the Home Learning Tab.
- A phone call from your child's new teacher before the end of term
