## Our topic is People Who Help Us!

#### RE

In RE the children have been exploring stories focusing on what we can learn from them. We read the story 'The Rainbow Fish' and talked about how we can be kind to others.

## **Communication and Language**

This week we have been learning about firefighters. On Thursday, Sandyford Fire Crew visited us. The children loved speaking to the crew and asked some brilliant questions.

## **PSHE**

This week we have been focusing on fire safety. The children looked at how fire fighters work to keep people safe when there is a fire. We talked about how to stay safe around fires and what to do in an emergency.

#### **Understanding the World**

The children are learning about looking after the environment this term. We have been looking at recycling and what this means. The children have been hands on this week and sorted through some recycling. They put the rubbish into groups: paper, metal, glass and plastic.

#### **Maths**

The children have exploring position this week. They have looked at how to describe the position of an object. E.g. the cup is on top of the box, the cup is next to the box etc. This is something you can practice at home easily! Why not give it a try.
