



Our topic is People Who Help Us!

RE

In RE the children have been exploring stories focusing on what we can learn from them. We read the story 'The Proudest Blue' and discussed the value of diversity and feeling proud of your identity.

Communication and Language

Physical Education

This term we have been focusing on learning traditional playground games with this week's focus being on the game hopscotch. We have talked about why it is important to warm up our bodies before exercise and practised moving around the playground safely.

Understanding the World

The children are learning about looking after the environment this term. We have been looking at recycling and what this means. The children have created their own bright and colourful recycling signs using a collage technique to encourage recycling in the school.

Expressive Arts and Design

We are learning about nutrition this term – the children have followed a recipe to make a play-doh salad.

Maths

The children have explored comparing groups using mathematical language such as 'more' and 'fewer'. They have explored groups of physical objects and images of groups.

Literacy

This week the children have been enjoying reading the book 'Supertato!'. The children have designed a 'WANTED!' poster to warn others of the dangers of the Evil Pea!

We have also been recapping the sounds we know in phonics. We have been recapping and identifying the beginning sound of everyday words which will then support the children with their future reading and writing skills.
