Literacy

In Literacy this week our focus stories have been about police officers and fire fighters. We have looked at more detail in what these services offer and the children have talked about keeping safe and what to do in an emergency. Once again the children have completed some wonderful writing activities from captions and key words to writing in full sentences.

Physical Development

We continued to progress with our ball skills in PE this week, with the children becoming more and more confident in throwing and catching, and building upon those all-important hand eye coordination skills. They worked well with partners and in teams as we ended our session with a game of 'Over! Under!' (3)

Maths

This week in Maths we looked at numbers to 20, counting accurately to 20 and identifying the corresponding numerals to each of the amounts. The children completed 'colour by number' activities and also worked on their number formation when writing the numerals down.
