Our topic is Space!



We have been thinking about pets this week. After reading the book 'Laika:

Communication and Language

Astronaut Dog', the children discussed whether they had any pets and if they did would they send them to space. We spoke about what their pets would need whilst in space.

Personal Social Emotional development

This week the children have been continued to learn about how to keep our bodies healthy. We have looked at exercise and what we need to do to keep our bodies fit and healthy. The children looked at some different exercises they can do. We did squats, jumping, running, dancing etc.

Understanding the World

We operate an open door policy, so please feel free to come and discuss any matters including celebratory


Maths
