Welcome to this week's newsletter. Spring is certainly in the air with some lovely sunshine even though it's still a bit chilly!





THREADWORMS

We have recently seen a small increase of children having worms. These are linked to hygiene and cleanliness, and are easily passed on. Please see the following link for some advice - https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/worms-in-humans/

To prevent worm infections:

- wash your hands before eating or preparing food, and after touching soil or using the toilet
- only drink bottled or boiled water in high-risk areas (places without modern toilets or sewage systems)
- thoroughly wash garden-grown fruit and vegetables
- deworm pet dogs and cats regularly
- dispose of dog and cat poo in a bin as soon as possible
