### **YEAR 2 DRUMROOTS WORKSHOP**

To support their topic this half term on Africa, Year 2 will be taking part in a Drumming Workshop on the morning of **Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> July**. The workshop will be delivered by a company called Drumroots who use their skills and knowledge of drumming as a tool for obtaining positive results in an educational environment. The children will have the opportunity to explore their individual musical abilities in a hands-on drumming session, as well as learning how drums are used in Africa to imitate speech patterns and are used to make announcements or warnings.

### **YEAR 5 RESIDENTIAL**

KS2 children will come to school in normal uniform as they can get changed at home before returning for the Disco. Any KS2 in Y2K can bring their disco clothes in a bag and get changed beforehand.
