YEAR 1 AUDIOLOGY

The Bolton NHS Foundation Trust Healthy Families Team will be in school on **Wednesday 28th January** offering a Hearing Screening to all children in **Year 1**.

Your child will have a hearing test, using headphones for each ear, to check their response to predetermined sounds; the screening will be completed in a private area in small groups of no more than three children. If your child requires a referral for further assessment following the results of the screening the audiology team will contact you. All screening equipment will be thoroughly cleaned after each child.

Please note your child will be screened for hearing unless you email the Healthy Families Team on HF@boltonft.nhs.uk to inform them that you wish to withdraw consent.
