Hello and welcome to our latest newsletter. How lovely is it seeing the sun in the sky and the daffodils swaying in the gentle breeze! Welcome to Spring.




Remember to buy your tickets for Easter Bingo on Wednesday 9th April from the office, it's not to be missed and don't forget your dabbers!
