WATER BOTTLES

Friendly reminder, we are a healthy school and **only water** is allowed in children's water bottle, unless otherwise stated with a medical note. Thank you for your continued support.

MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS

Please note, for all medical appointments (hospital, doctors, dentist etc) made during school time, proof of appointment is required. Please provide this at the Office or send to Mrs Wall on Dojo.

FREE SCHOOL MEAL ELIGIBILITY

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-Based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 they will receive Universal Free School Meals funded by the Government. However, if you are eligible for benefit related free school meals, please apply as all children who are in receipt of free school meals at St Stephen's will also benefit from school trips being funded by school.

ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY

School attendance is hugely important. For your child to gain the full benefit from their education, for their learning, wellbeing, and wider development, they need to attend on time, every day possible.

School gates **open at 8:40am** and **close at 8:55am**. We are seeing an increase in children arriving after the gates have closed, and when the registers have closed. Please note, lates and unauthorised absences are flagged with the Local Authority and may result in fine.

10 sessions (5 days of unauthorised absence in a 10-week period)

Penalty Notice Fines will be considered when there have been 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10-week period. This means 5 full days. Being more than 30 minutes late to school will count as 1 session of unauthorised absence.

Penalty Notice Fines for Attendance is changing

NEW CHANGES FROM 19TH AUGUST 2024

1

1st OFFENCE

The first time a penalty notice is given for absence, the cost will be:

£160 per parent, per child.

This will be £80 if paid within 21 days.

2

2nd OFFENCE (within 3 years)

The second time a penalty notice is given for absence, the cost will be:

£160 per parent, per child
to be paid within 28 days.

No reduced rate offered.

3

3 OR MORE OFFENCES (within 3 years)

If a third penalty notice is given for absence, you will not get a penalty notice. The case will be presented to the Magistrate's Court. Magistrates' fines can be up to **£2,500 per parent, per child.**

Guilty cases can show on parents' future DBS certificates, due to not safeguarding a child's education.



ILLNESSES
