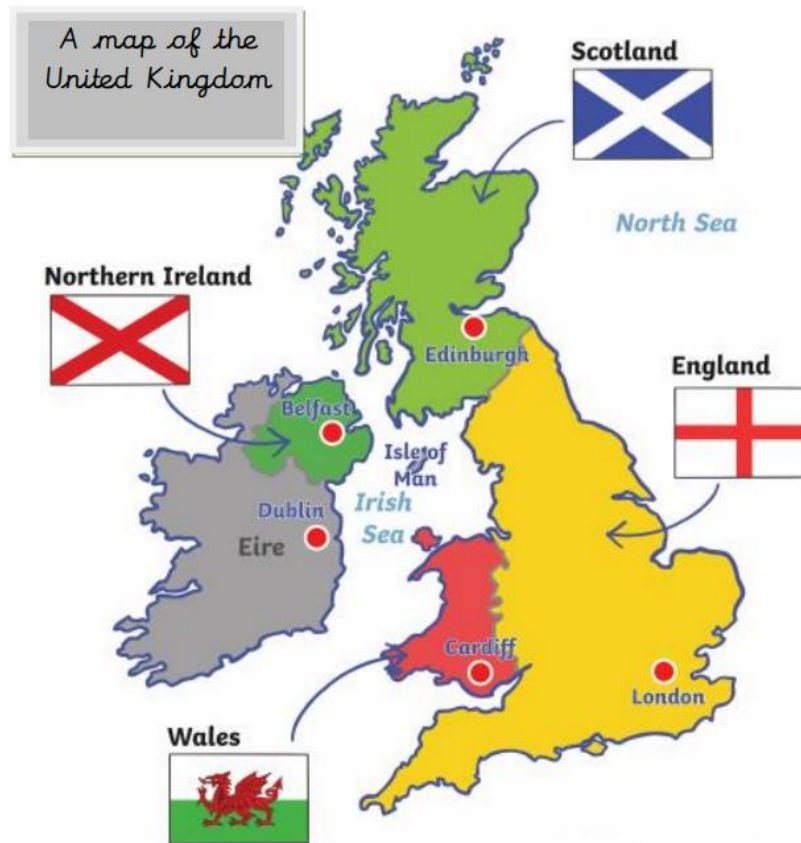

Vocabulary	Definition	Picture
capital city	The city of a country where the government sits.	
cathedral	A cathedral is a larger Christian church that is the home church of a bishop.	
city	A city is a large town that must have a cathedral. For example, Liverpool.	
country	An area of land, that makes up part of a continent. We live in the country of England.	
flag	A piece of cloth which can be attached to a pole and which is used as symbol of a particular country.	

Vocabulary	Definition	Picture
island	A piece of land that is completely surrounded by water.	
sea	A large area of salty water that is part of an ocean.	
town	A central place with streets and buildings, where people live and work. Leigh is a town.	
United Kingdom	It is made up of the countries England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.	
village	A village has a group of houses with other buildings such as a church and a school, in a country area.
