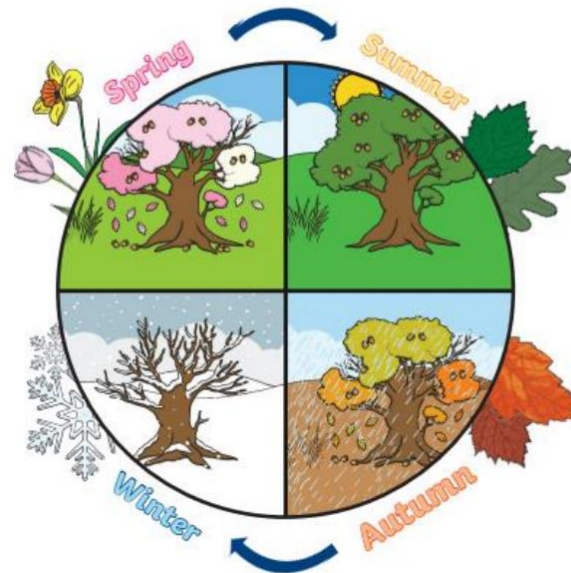

Order of Seasons

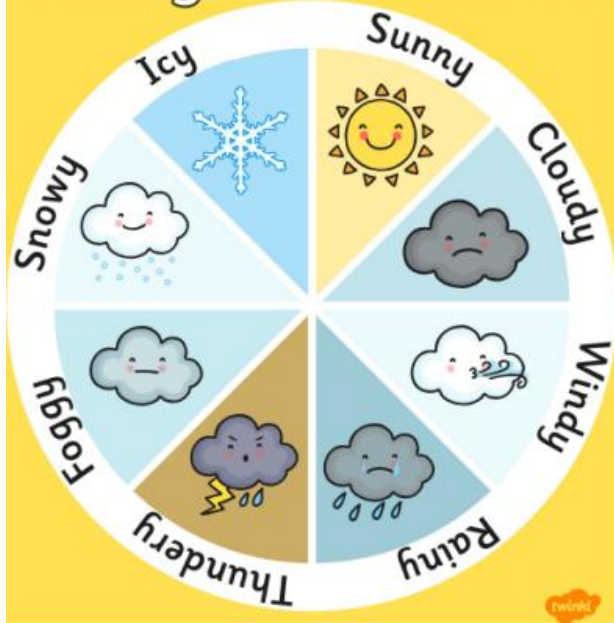

season	A time of the year with a particular type of weather
seasonal	When something is related to a particular time of year
temperature	How hot or cold it is
thermometer	A piece of equipment that measure temperature
weather forecast	Explaining what the weather will be like
cloud	A cloud is water in the atmosphere (air) that we can see. It is where rain and snow comes from.
rain	Rain is the liquid form of water that falls from the sky in drops.
snow	When a cloud is cold enough, the water vapour (water in the form of gas) freezes and becomes ice crystals which falls as snow.
day length	The amount of light in the day

Facts

There are four seasons in a year – Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.	In the U.K Summer has the longest days and the highest temperatures.
Four seasons are formed in one Year due to the earth travelling around the sun.	Autumn is the time when deciduous trees shed their leaves
In spring the weather usually turns warmer, trees begin to grow their leaves, plants start to flower and young animals such as chicks and lambs are born.	In the U.K Winter is the season with the shortest days and the lowest temperatures.

Our Weather

In a weather forecast, **symbols** are used to show what the weather will be like in a particular area. People check the weather forecast before they make plans for a day out. Computers are used to help make accurate weather forecasts.
