Ways to support learning at home:

- * Develop a love for rhythm and rhyme - Share and enjoy stories that rhyme. Listen carefully to spot the words that sound the same
- * Support early reading - reciting and singing nursery rhymes together
- * Develop an interest in number - Enjoy singing songs and playing games that explore the concept of one more and one less (5 Little Ducks, 5 Little Monkeys, 5 Currant Buns)
- * Develop communication - Encourage your child to talk about their day by asking questions like: What did you have for lunch? What has been your favourite part of the day? What did you do that was interesting or exciting? What made you smile or feel happy?
- * Support independence - Encourage turning jumpers, cardigans and coats the correct way, when they are inside out and practise putting on coats, hats, scarves and gloves
