In order for your child to settle quickly into Nursery and be ready to start learning s/he needs to be able to achieve the following:

I respond to my name and can look at an adult when they talk to me		
I am able to leave my Mummy/Daddy/my carer for a short period of time without getting upset		
I can ask an adult for help when I need it and be understood		
I can follow a simple instruction straight away		
I am able to listen to other adults and I can stop when I am told 'no'		
I walk and hold an adult's hand when asked, to keep safe		
I don't need nappies during the day		

I can go to the toilet independently		
I can wash and dry my hands, using soap		
I can put my shoes and socks on independently		
I can put my coat on by myself		
I have stopped using bottles and dummies		
I am able to sit at a table at lunchtime and eat my food using a knife and fork		
I have grown out of my pushchair
