(resources or sharing expertise):

Go on an Autumn walk. What can you see? Collect different coloured leaves, conkers, acorns and pine cones and bring them into Nursery to show to your friends and use in our Autumn sensory tray.

Ways to support learning at home:

- * Support toileting - encouraging your child to pull clothes up and down, flush the toilet and wash their hands
- * Support independence – encouraging your child to take off their own coat and shoes and putting them back on
- * Develop a love for books and stories – sharing and enjoying a bedtime story every night
- * Support early reading – reciting and singing nursery rhymes together
- * Support a sense of belonging – enjoying and sharing family photographs, talking about significant people in your child's life
- * Encourage new vocabulary - buy different fruit and vegetables from usual and make a fruit smoothie or fruit salad to introduce new language and tastes
- * Explore the senses - guess the fruit or vegetable by feeling or tasting. Talk about the texture and taste
