



School Uniform Policy

At Studley Infants' we have a suggested school uniform in order to encourage a sense of school pride, unity and community spirit. As members of Studley Infants' School all children are encouraged to observe this policy. Uniform does not have to have a School Logo on and the colours can be found at most supermarkets. If parents wish to order new uniform with the logo this can be ordered through Parentmail. The PTA do have some second-hand uniforms for sale during the year. School also has a small amount of older spare used school uniform in the case of emergencies.

Recommended Uniform

Please name all clothing and shoes.

Winter

- Black tracksuit bottom, trousers or leggings
- White or yellow short sleeved polo shirt (with or without logo)
- Black shoes with Velcro fastening (no laces)
- Royal blue long sleeved cardigan or sweatshirt (with or without school logo)
- Grey trousers or grey skirt/pinafore dress

Summer

- Grey school shorts
- Blue/white or yellow/white checked summer dress
- Closed toe sandals
- Caps/hats in hot weather

Outside Classroom

We do not wear uniform on Outside Classroom days

- Long sleeved top
- Full length tracksuit bottoms/jeans
- Waterproof coat
- Appropriate comfortable shoes
- caps/hats in hot/cold weather

PE

To be worn in school on designated days for PE

- Shorts
- T-shirt (no inappropriate slogans)
- Pumps (no laces)
- PE bag
- Caps in hot weather
- Sweatshirt and joggers for colder days

Additional Uniform Items
• Book Bag • Spare clothes – every child needs to have spare clothes in a named carrier bag or small rucksack. This will remain in school on your child's peg at all times, so that it is available when needed, just in case your child has a toilet accident or if s/he need changing from having lots of fun with the messy play. In this bag, please provide, a spare top, bottoms, pants, socks, wipes if necessary, extra carrier bag to send home soiled clothes. NB all spare clothes and uniform, including shoes, must have your child's name on so we can help locate them if they get misplaced.
Other items/requirements
• A suitable coat should be brought to school every day during winter/colder/wet months. A suitable coat should be waterproof and warm. • Wellies – your child will need a pair of wellies to remain at school with his/her name marked inside. • Sun hats or caps should be brought to school to be worn during outside play on sunny day
Makeup and Jewellery
• Makeup is not permitted. • Jewellery should be Stud earrings only. Other jewellery such as bracelets and necklaces should not be worn for health and safety reasons, as well as the possibility of them becoming lost. • Children wearing earrings other than stud earrings will be asked to remove them. If the child is not able to remove them, tape will be applied to minimise risk to the ear.
