Ways to support learning at home:

* Develop a love for books and stories – share and enjoy a bedtime story every night. Encourage your child to hold the book, turn the pages and talk about the pictures. Don't forget to stop when you get to a tricky word for your child to read

* Support independence – encourage your child to take off their gloves and put them into their coat pockets, take off their hat and put it down their coat sleeve and take off their scarf and put it down their other coat sleeve

* Develop an interest in number – enjoy a family winter walk and make a collection of objects exploring 6,7 and 8 (6– stones, 7 – sticks, 8 – leaves.) Don't forget to take a picture and post it on Seesaw!

* Develop a sense of resilience and a 'can do attitude' – identify something that is tricky for your child to do and set a challenge for them to overcome such as putting on shoes, zipping up their coat, using a knife and fork, brushing their teeth
