# Target Students

Age: Year 8 (12 – 13 years old)

## At Risk of Disengagement

- Narrowly missing 5 level 4 or above at GCSE
- Narrowly missing their predicted grades
- Low attainment
- Low self-confidence
- Low attendance

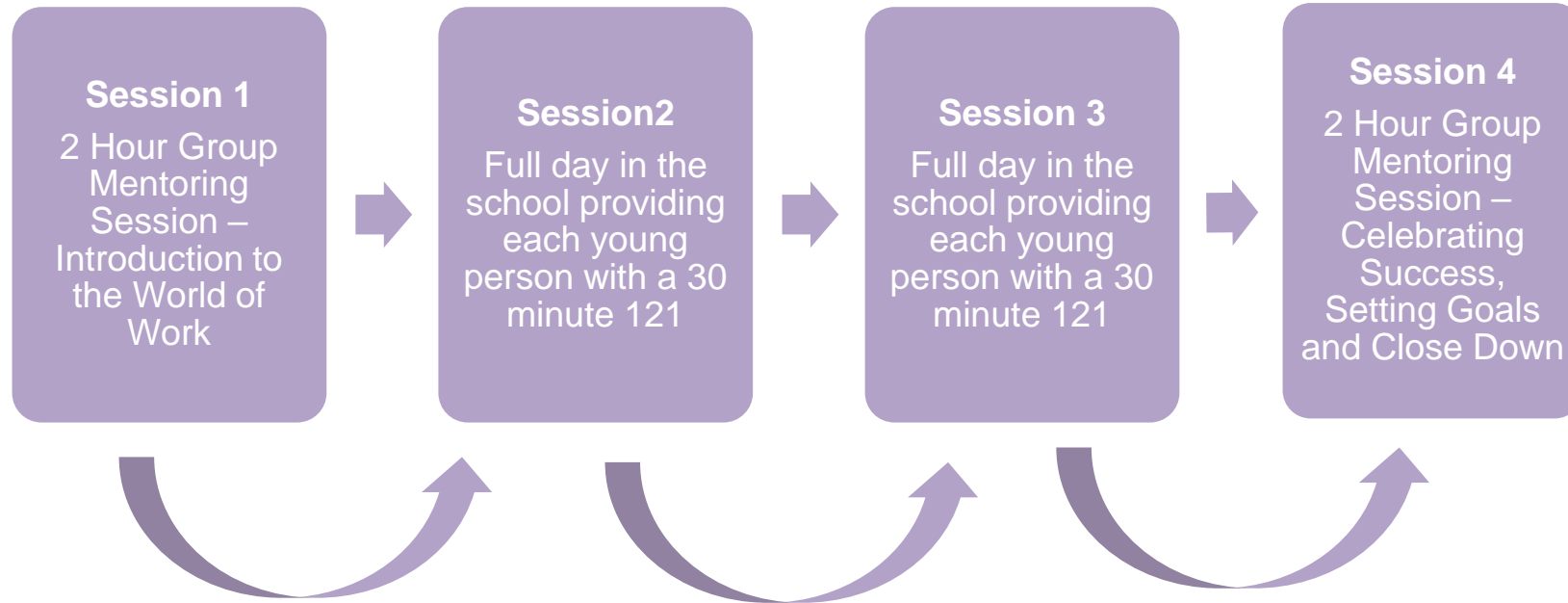
## Background

- May come from poorer social economic backgrounds
- Lack a strong support system
- May not have any members of family in employment
- Large families

## Educational Needs

- Range of different abilities and may have ECHPs in place or Special Educational Needs, including:
  - Learning difficulties
  - Dyslexia
  - Autism
  - ADHD

- Activity from Student Workbook

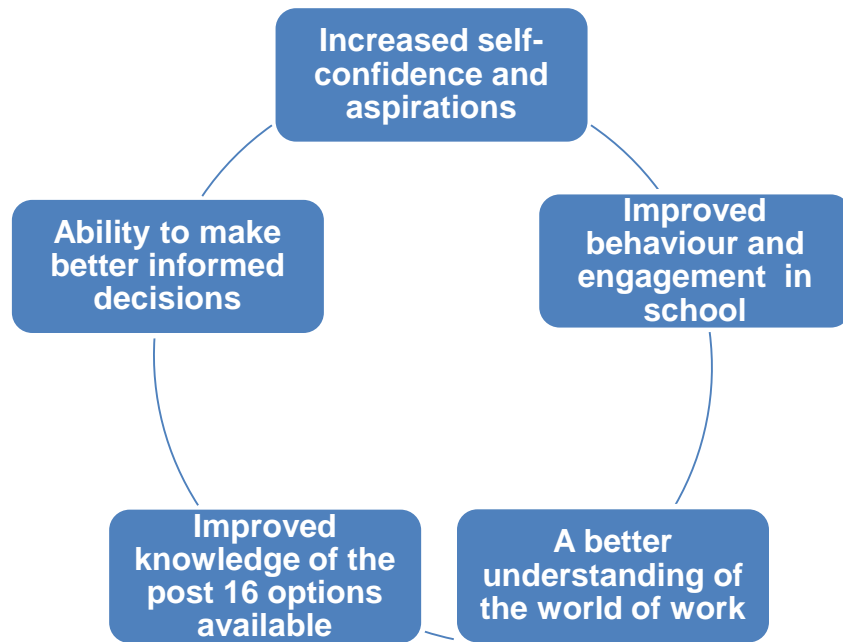
## Session 4 - 2 hour group session
