

School and Metamorphosis Pilot Project Agreement

Project Intent is as follows:

- To implement a trauma-informed approach to teaching and learning by adopting a set of trauma-informed principles (PHYSICAL, EMOTIONAL, SOCIAL, AND ACADEMIC SAFETY) to inform educational policies and procedures. (The principles are specific enough to provide a useful framework but general enough to be adapted for and operationalized within a variety of settings)
- To provide a holistic programme of support for the most vulnerable children and young people so that they don't lose out on their future or lose hope in their own potential
- To ensure that groups with high vulnerability or special needs have access and dignity in attaining the education they need to thrive.
- To specialize in providing education for children and young adults in fragile settings, many of whom are at risk of dropping out or being left behind. Our vision is for education to be fundamentally life-transforming.
- To recognise that *all* children have the right to access and complete a full course of education opportunities.
- The pilot project will ensure or enable children/ young people to leave school with the relevant knowledge and skills that will enable them to be employable, and make a positive contribution to society
- To recognise that Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) are potentially traumatic events that occur in childhood and to Lower risk for conditions like depression, asthma, cancer, and diabetes in adulthood through appropriate intervention and Improving education and employment potential and finally...
- To stop ACEs from being passed from one generation to the next.
