Dear Parents and Carers,

With the increasing rates of COVID-19 in our populations and the recommendation for 12-15 year olds to receive two doses of COVID vaccination we are writing to confirm where you can get your child vaccinated during the winter holidays.

Appointments can continue to be made at mass vaccination sites, pharmacies and some GP's through the national booking service. You can find details on how to book, locations of community sessions, plus available time slots at: <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/coronavirus-vaccination/book-coronavirus-vaccination/> or by scanning this QR code:



Walk in appointments may also be available at some of these sites or at one the 'Pop Up' sites that are being organised to support the expedited vaccination programme. Young people aged 12-15 will soon be able to book a second COVID vaccination 12 weeks after their first dose. The 12 week interval is recommended due to emerging evidence from the UK and other countries, which suggests that leaving a longer interval between infection and vaccination may further reduce the already small risk of myocarditis in younger age groups. It is also for this reason that young people under 18 years of age should not receive a COVID vaccination until 12 weeks after testing positive for COVID-19 unless they are clinically vulnerable or live with someone who is immunocompromised.
