Topic

History: Romans

Pupils will learn about the impact of the Roman Empire on Britain. They will:

- Learn facts about the Roman Empire and how it affected people.
- Understand the history of Hadrian's Wall.
- Learn about the roles of different people in Roman society.
- Learn about a Roman soldier's helmet decoration and design.
- Learn and use Roman Numerals in various activities.

English-Myths and Legends

Pupils will look at the poem 'The Wolf'

- Choose effective fronted adverbials.
- Compose a poem about a wolf.
- Improve a descriptive poem.
- Understand similes.
- Make links from information about a character.
- Explain the features of mythical creatures..

Food Technology

Weekly lessons - Tuesdays

Where food originates from, how it is grown, reared and caught and how it is processed. Pupils will be researching different food groups and how to plan healthy and varied meals. Developing their confidence with knife skills, weighing and measuring and cooking.
