



Primary & Nurture Summer Term 2020 Curriculum Offer

At Sutton House Academy we understand the barriers our pupils face as they transition back to school, following the COVID-19 pandemic. Therefore, we have adapted our curriculum to meet their needs.

Transition back will be slow to allow pupils to adjust to change. Pupils will attend initial sessions with a high staff ratio to give pupils confidence that most things at school have remained the same and support them to deal with the things that have changed. Staff will use visual timetables, to introduce a fun hand washing routine throughout their time at school. Staff will spend time with pupils through craft activities, outdoor activities and physical activities. These include gardening, painting, various sports indoor and outdoor, outdoor sand and mud kitchen area, crafting, art activities to build their confidence, support independence and ease concerns.

Learning will be led by individual pupil's EHCP needs and we will ensure during the first few weeks their communication, social and sensory needs are supported to allow them to adapt to change and support a successful transition back to school.
