Notes:

» Pupil voice representatives' feedback on lunch times.

- Happy that portions have got bigger.
- Happy that they are sticking to the menu.
- Student want to have lunch times mixed again, and have the full 30 minutes which they had before. Reasons for this it would help divide secondary and the stigma around "Reach", also they have friends either side and don't get to spend time with them. If 30 minutes they were together the ones what take longer to eat lunch wouldn't be a problem as they feel they are rushed eating lunch and don't have enough time before having to leave. It also means more staff on duty which would help solve problems, and having more staff on duty will help stop anything from occurring.

» Pupil voice representatives discussed the toilets of both secondary and reach.

- Toilet roll is not being re stocked up and is always half empty boys don't get any and sometimes boys need to go for a poo.
- Hand dryers take too long in reach to dry hands.
- Only 1 soap dispenser working properly in female toilets and sometimes in the boy's soap is empty.
- All the toilets both sides seem to have stench smell and they don't smell clean they said maybe "an air refresher"

- Secondary toilets always smell fruity from vapes.

» Pupil voice representatives negative feedback in general

- Pupils are asking where secondary bike rack is as it's been a long time since got told it's coming? They said students don't feel their bikes are safe, and that when a student is heightened it gets taken out on their bikes. Also, with the weather bikes chains and seats getting ruined.

- KS4 Reach out complaining about how much noise is affecting them from primary with doors kicking, they don't like it.

- Secondary not happy there is not enough laptops and sometimes when they would like a laptop to do work on there is any or batteries are dead can we not get laptops for every class?

- Too many students doing too much damage to the school and they don't like there is different rules and consequences for every child. Too many people get away with stuff.

- Secondary feel it's not fair a few can have mobile phones in school to listen to music but the majority can't. They said if they can't have their phones then those students shouldn't either. Plus it could be a safe guarding issue if pupils have phones on them. All students have access to music on laptops and all should have same rules.

- Too many students disturbing other people's PE lessons and refusing to get out of the hall.

- Damp and mould in English 2 room and it's very cold some days. Also, too many objects on the ceiling and some worry something will fall on their heads. They would like this fixed as they don't like the idea to work in those conditions.

- Rooms look messy and dirty.

- Pupils still waiting for after school clubs to be available.

Secondary don't like the mixture of year 9's and 10's together as some of those people stills KS3 and feel they do a lot more than their other peers and have to do OS and NCFE too early.
