Notes:

» Pupil voice representatives' feedback on lunch times.

- Would love to see fruits like melon/watermelon at lunch times
- Was asking about carrot sticks and cucumber sticks and lemons for lunch
- Would love to see all day breakfast, pizza, beef burgers, cheese and bacon pastry to be back on the menu.
- Portion sizes seem on the small size especially when secondary go in the hall.
- Baguettes are either too soft or don't taste fresh, loads of the children taking a few bites and then throwing away or skipping having them, pupil voice suggested rolls or paninis.
- 3 students in the reach corridor are dairy free and when its ice-cream for desert they were wondering can we get dairy free ice cream.
- Students miss the hot deserts especially as we have hit Winter.
- When there are meat dishes on the menu can we have an alternative meat free dish which is not a jacket potato.
- Pupils have to order a week in advance for their lunch, students are asking is there no way they can order or the day or night before as this might save wastage and that sometimes students order food and then when it comes to that day next week they are not in the mood and don't want that food but then they have to have it when they don't want it.

» Pupil voice representatives discussed the toilets of both secondary and reach.

- Toilet roll is not being re stocked up and is always half empty boys don't get any and sometimes boys need to go for a poo.

- Toilets never seem clean.
- All the toilets both sides of secondary and reach seem to have stench smell and they don't smell clean they said maybe "an air refresher"
- Secondary toilets always smell fruity from vapes.

» Laptops and headphones

- Students say there is not enough laptops and that half the laptops the battery die or don't work properly.

Students feel is there no way that every room could have laptops or to make sure VOC subjects have their own laptops due to that they need them for research but sometimes they cant get them due to English or ICT lessons going on.

Students also mentioned could we not order enough headphones the big black chunky ones (Neve will know which ones) for every student in the school and then each tutor will keep there's and have there names on and that if damaged or lost student to replace or go without as students don't like sharing headphones and there isn't really any.

- Students really don't like the school jumpers and a lot of students have sensory issues and don't like the feel of them. Students have said can we not make a SHA hoodie as everyone would wear this and all students would look smart as in uniform it also helps with their sensory needs, this also stops people arguing that some get to wear their cardigan/hoody of their choice.

- Students have asked could we have courses like Victory park or allow all the girls to go hair and beauty at VP due to some girls from reach and other secondary girls would like to go. Also the boys and some girls would like a wood shop class they could do even if it teaches the basic putting up a shelf or putting furniture together as it's a life skill for future.

- Students asked if update on when pool table will arrive also if we could get some more games as like Minecraft etc ... also need a charger cable as controls out of charge, for the common room. Also if we could get some new board games.

The girls would like something but not sure to make it more girl friendly. Also if we could get more bean bags and chairs that would be nice. Also the common room smell of damp seems to be coming back and is always very cold in the room.

Could the students have Spotify this is because sound cloud is more slow and doesn't always work. Spotify most students could access on their own account and the fact most students like to listen to music and is one of their strategies would help. Also, could there be games for them to do especially as most things are blocked.

The students would like that the school fences and the back of the school and front of the school get replaced or better lick of paint, this is because they don't look attractive and also looks like a prison. They feel if they get changed/painted it would look more inviting for people to come look at our school.

Students from the lock down practice have mentioned what would happen if they need to get in contact with there parents if we were in lock down as all phones locked away in the back cupboard how will the school contact parents this seems a worry especially in Reach corridor. Maybe in assembly SLT could go to secondary and Reach and reassure them about phones being locked away and what would happen if lockdown was to happen.
