» Pupil voice representatives were updated on feedback from SLT:

- School photos will be taken by school, professionally printed. Frames will be supplied.
- Afterschool clubs – science club is already running on Tuesday afternoon, Art club focusing on fine motor skills will start in near future.
- Food menu – Pupil voice would like to invite kitchen staff to our next meeting to share suggestions and feedback.
- School corridors revamp will start during Easter holidays.
- Bike rack and shelter – agreed by SLT, maintenance team to make decision on cost and overall arrangements.
- Agreed budget by SLT: £500 for trips, £500 rewards, £500 games, toys etc. for classrooms.
- Pupil voice “fresh start” from September – one elected member per class.

» Pupil voice representatives were set a task to find out from peers how the school can help locally and internationally. The following suggestions were shared:

- Shoebox – either for local or international charity – fill up a shoebox with essentials, items needed for particular child’s age groups.
- Non-uniform Day – Pay a £1 for not wearing school uniform. Raised money to be donated to either local or international charity.
- Going to residential care homes – to read, to chat with older members of our community, Christmas Carol singing).

- Bring a tin Day – to donate food for local food bank.
- Collection of essentials for homeless people (toiletries, hats, gloves, blankets etc).
- Invite speakers from local charities to raise awareness and suggest ideas how we can help as a school.

» Pupil voice representatives' task:

- To find out what sensory toys/games each class would like or need.

» SLT to discuss and give feedback:

- Pupils would like to access and monitor how many positive Sleuth points they have earned.
- Pupils would like rewards for positive Sleuth points.
- Pupils would like to have visitors/speakers in assemblies to learn about different cultures and religions.
- SLT to involve STA staff who have worked/supported local charities to try to invite speakers in.
