Geography - Let's explore the world

Pupils will learn about:

- atlases, maps and cardinal compass points.
- They learn about the characteristics of the four countries of the United Kingdom and find out why there are hot, temperate and cold places around the world.
- Pupils will carry out fieldwork, collecting primary data in their locality to answer geographical questions.

Food Technology - every other week
