Re: GCSE Mock Examinations – Important Information

We are writing to inform you that our **GCSE Mock Examinations** will take place from **Monday, 16th March 2026**. These mock exams are an essential part of your child's GCSE preparation, allowing staff to recognise strengths and weaknesses across the subject and for individuals. A letter has been sent out previously but there have been some changes and these have been shared with pupils.

We have scheduled the Math's and English examinations across two separate weeks to allow pupils to focus on one subject at a time. This decision was made in response to parental feedback, and we appreciate your continued support in helping us create the best possible conditions for our pupils to succeed.

All mock exams will take place under exam conditions and will replicate the exam environments in the summer. Access arrangements will be followed based on individual needs. I have included the exam boards that we use at Sutton House to encourage students to visit past papers online for preparation.
