To minimise the effects of the heat, we will be:

- Ensuring that drinking water is readily available and encouraging pupils to stay hydrated.
- Using fans and keeping classrooms well-ventilated where possible.
- Adjusting activities to avoid prolonged periods outside during the hottest parts of the day.
- Making use of shaded areas when pupils are outdoors.
- Monitoring pupils closely and responding appropriately to any signs of heat-related discomfort.

We would appreciate your support by:

- Applying sun cream to your child before they come to school each morning.
- Sending your child to school with a named sun hat or cap, which they may wear when outside.
- Ensuring your child brings a refillable water bottle to school each day.
