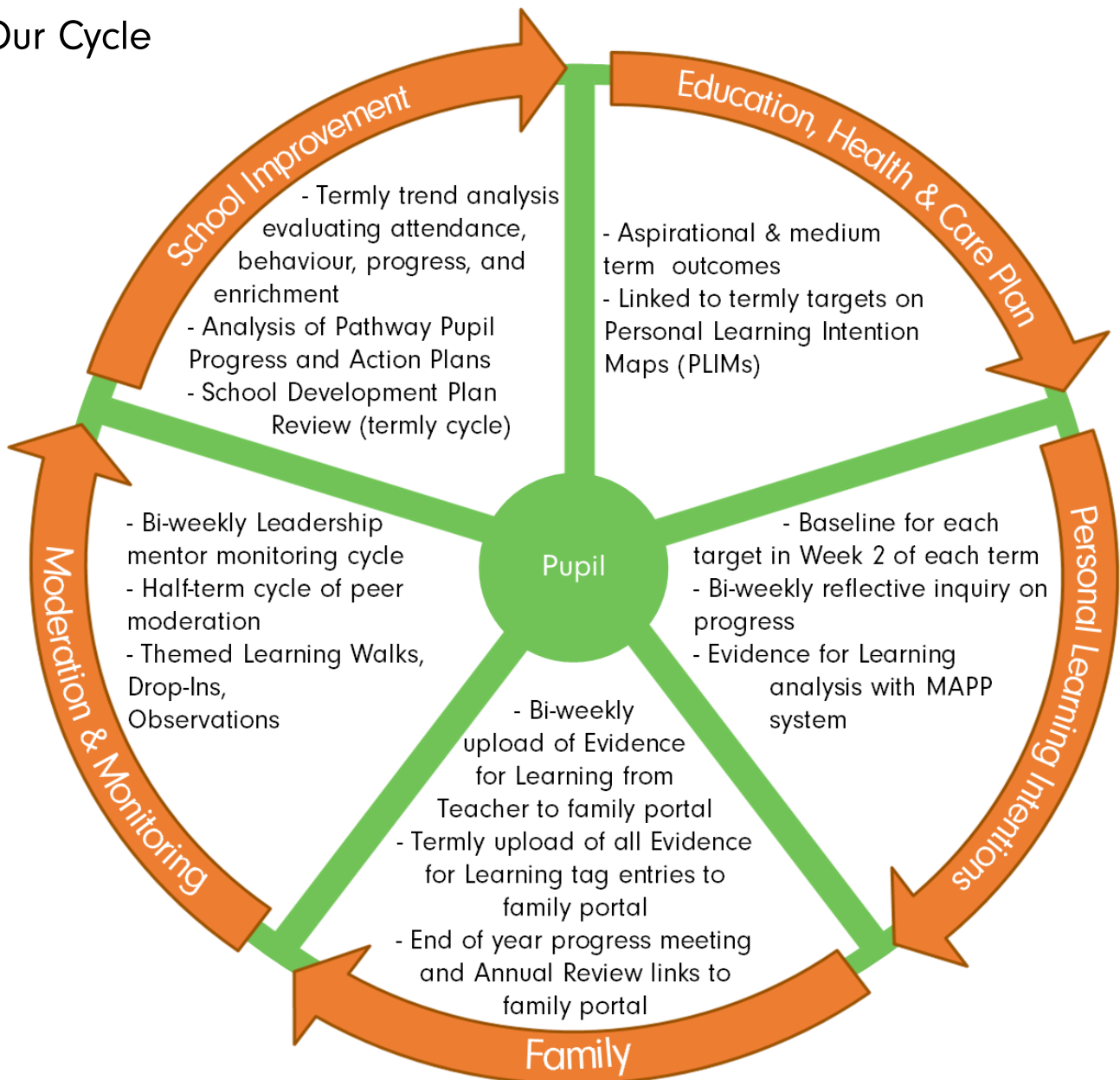


Assessment Process
