We work in partnership with the local authority (education, health & social care) and other service providers to influence how they commission, plan and deliver services to meet the needs of children and young people with SEND.

## What do we do?

**We run regular forums and meetings, bringing together parents with speakers from the local authority and local services:**

- 1** Special Parents Forum  
For all parents and carers of children and young people (0-25yrs) with special educational needs and disabilities.
- 2** Transition Forum  
For all parents and carers of those aged 14+ years who are moving into adulthood.
- 3** Coffee Mornings  
We also run informal coffee mornings.
