This workshop will be suitable for anyone with a non-verbal child or a child who has some words but does not use them very functionally to communicate with others. (This could be a child any age)


We will explore ways of building children's communication using a range of strategies such as pictures, objects and signs. There will be time for you to ask questions and share your experiences with other parents during the course of the session.
